DIRECTIONS:

From the M4 Junction 10, take the A322 towards Bracknell. Stay on the A322 and follow signs to M3. Turn left off the A322 on to the A332 (the A322 is now a dual carriageway through woodland) signed Legoland and Ascot. Buttersteep Rise is on your right, opposite The Berkshire Golf Course.

From the M4 Junction 6 to Windsor, Windsor to Ascot passing by Legoland and Ascot Race Course. Pick up the A332 at the Race Course, signed M3. Turn left in to Buttersteep Rise opposite The Berkshire Golf Course.

From the M3 Junction 3, take the A322 to Bracknell, at the Junction of the A332 signed Legoland and Ascot, turn right. Buttersteep Rise is on your right, opposite The Berkshire Golf Course.
